- The maximum score by all players on each hole will be +4. If a player is assured of scoring no better than +4 on the hole, they MUST pick up and continue to the next hole.
- Parents must remain on the cart paths and at least 30 yards from the players. Parents are encouraged to serve as forecaddies ahead of
  play to spot shots. Once the player arrives in the area, the parents should leave the area immediately without giving any advice to the
  player. Parents and spectators should not inject themselves into the competition by trying to serve as a Rules Official.
- Each school may have one designated coach that will receive an identifying wrist band. Coaches will have the option to attend a certification class at each Regional and State Championship. Non-certified coaches may only speak to their players between the putting green and the teeing ground on the next hole. During the play of the hole, the non-certified coaches should not be speaking to the players. Certified coaches will also have the ability to talk to the players during the play of the hole (without holding up pace of play), but may not walk on the putting green or enter hazards except during a search. Players are considered individual competitors for this competition.
- Registration is completed on an individual basis for this event. Teams can consist of any combination of boys and girls attending the same school. Players at feeder schools may be a part of a team if they will definitively attend that school in the future. There is no limit on the number of teams entered from the same school. After completing individual registration, coaches or parents may submit a team listing through e-mail to Ray Moehlman at <a href="mailto:rmoehlman@kygolf.org">rmoehlman@kygolf.org</a>. Teams must consist of at least 4 players and no more than 5 players. If a team qualifies for the State Championship, they may substitute any player that has played in a Regional Championship or a Kentucky PGA Junior Tour event during the season. If a team has only 4 players at the Regional level, they may not expand to 5 members at the State Championship. Team rosters must be submitted no later than midnight on <a href="mailto:moehlman@moehlman
- The team scoring format uses the best 4 of 5 scores on the Regional level. At least one team, one individual boy, and one individual girl will advance to the State Championship. Additional spots in the State Championship will be distributed based on the number of participants at each Regional location. If there is a tie for the final qualifying spot, all involved in the tie will advance to the State Championship.
- All players agree to have photos of their likeness used for promotional purposes by the Kentucky Section of the PGA as well as the
  Kentucky PGA Junior Tour. Individual players are responsible for their own safety during the course of play. Golf House Kentucky cannot
  be held liable for any injuries as a result play in this event.

The Regional Qualifier entry fee is \$51.50, and payments are processed upon receipt. Players may only enter one (1) Regional.
